



Access within Whistler Blackcomb's Controlled Recreational Area is permitted only on the designated routes. Users assume all risks related to travel on the designated routes. Please respect all on mountain signage and instruction from Patrol.

## For your safety, you must abide by the following rules:

Travel off of designated routes is strictly prohibited.

Routes can be opened or closed at Patrol discretion.

Ascend single file.

Stay on the downhill side of the route.

Watch for skiers above.

Be aware of moving equipment: Snowmobiles, Snowcats and Winch Cats.

Check for up to date avalanche conditions and terrain closures before re-entering the Ski Area Boundary. (604) 905-2324
